AUTO PARTS IN BANGLADESH

The market size of automotive components was about Tk 1,300 crore to Tk 1,400 crore last year with an annual growth rate of 10 to 12 percent in the last one decade, said one of the major importers. At least 200 traders import auto spare parts and most of them have workshops. More than 2,500 traders are involved in the component business. Furthermore, although the sector is growing, no trader has the capacity to set up plants to make spare parts. Annual growth rate 10 to 12 percent! Considering these factors, CEMS-Global decided that hosting an exhibition for this industry would be highly beneficial for all parties.

The Auto parts market has more than doubled in a matter of a decade driven by rising car users in Bangladesh. Importers mostly import the engine, alternator, radiator, air conditioner, suspension, brake pads, spoiler, rim, tyre, trim package, body components, and other spare parts products that are in demand in the auto parts industry. The market size was only around Tk 500 crore just a decade ago. However, this market is growing rapidly because of the rise of using reconditioned cars on the roads. Bangladesh is an undisputed growth region for the reconditioned cars for the last decades.

INDUSTRIES SECTOR WITH RECORD BREAKING FIGURES

Bangladesh is facing a rise in the demand for motorized vehicles. Within this decade, a total of 0.32 million vehicles has been registered in Bangladesh according to the list given in the official website of Bangladesh Road Transport Authority (BRTA). In 2016, there has been an increase of registered vehicles totaling 0.42 million vehicles. For the last couple of years, it has been increasing at a significant rate which is why demand for Auto Parts is also on the rise.

There has been a big jump in the purchasing capacity of the middle class. The standard public transport in Dhaka and the affordable price of cars are also reasons for the boost.

At least 200 traders import auto spare parts and most of them have workshops business here in Bangladesh. More than 2,500 traders are involved in this automotive component business. The light engineering sector manufactures some auto parts but the quantity is very low. However, all kinds of spare parts of motor cars are available in the market.








